UNESCO-Bangladesh Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman International Prize for the Creative Economy

The purpose of the Prize is to recognize and reward innovative projects or programmes undertaken by an individual, institution, entity or non-governmental organization to promote entrepreneurship in the creative economy (such as cinema/audio-visual,design, media arts, music, performing arts, publishing, and visual arts etc) by young people starting from the age of 16.

Created in 2020 following the decision of the UNESCO Executive Board (210 EX/15), and named after **Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman**, Father of the nation of Bangladesh, the Prize will be awarded for the first time in 2021. The Prize winner shall receive a monetary award of US \$50,000.
